

Auditions for Alice in Wonderland

Please Note: If your child would just like to be in the ensemble without a featured part, they do not need to attend auditions. You still must create an account and register for the class. Please email nate@phelpsc.org stating your child would like a part in the ensemble. Actors who'd like a featured part must register via gomotion and attend auditions.

All actors who would like a featured part in the production must attend auditions.

When: Auditions will be held on Saturday, Sep. 30th from 1 PM - 4 PM.

Who: Actors ages 6-18

Where: 8 Banta Street, Phelps PCC Dance Studio wing.

What to expect: The day will start with a group dance call where the auditionees will be taught a small dance combination from the show.

Attire: Comfortable athletic wear socks or dance shoes(Ballet or Jazz). No jewelry, dresses, or denim.

What to Prepare:

After the group dance audition, participants will one by one perform a 30-second song and a short monologue. These should be prepared prior to the audition.

Song:

Please have your child prepare **either** the song below or **30 seconds** of their favorite pop / Disney / Musical Theatre song. They can do it with or without a backing YouTube track.

MONOLOGUE: Please have your child choose only **one** of the following monologues to audition with:

Monologue #1

Character Oscar from *The Odd Couple*

“Tell you exactly what it is. It’s the cooking, cleaning and crying.... It’s the talking in your sleep, it’s the moose calls that open your ears at two o’clock in the morning....

I can’t take it anymore, Felix. I’m crackin’up. Everything you do irritates me. And when you’re not here, the things I know you’re gonna do when you come in irritate me....

You leave me little notes on my pillow. I told you a hundred times, I can’t stand little notes on my pillow. “We’re all out of Corn Flakes. F.U.”....

It took me three hours to figure out that F.U. was Felix Unger.... It’s not your fault, Felix. It’s a rotten combination. That’s just the frame.

Monologue #2

Character Florence from *The Odd Couple*

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Aspirin is good...I can't move my neck. And a scarf. A woolen scarf...Cashmere is better if you have one. (Beat) I knew something was coming, Olive. I knew we were in trouble. In the middle of the night I would tiptoe into the bathroom and I would pray, "Please, God, please help me save my marriage. Please, God, tell me what to do. Tell me what I'm doing wrong. Please, God, help me"...And then I'd hear Sidney in the bathroom saying, "Please, God, make her shut up. Tell her to be quiet, please, God"...I'm not a complainer. I've never once tried to change Sidney...he wears a toupee*two sizes too big, he looks like an English sheep dog, I never said a word!
